## **FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS**

- 1. Why were the Pharisees and scribes trying to "trap" Jesus? In what ways were they doing this?
- 2. What does this passage tell us about how Jesus views people?
- 3. After forgiving the woman, Jesus tells her to "leave your life of sin" in verse 11. Moral purity (holiness) was very important to Jesus. How can the grace of Jesus motivate you to holiness?
- 4. We see that Jesus saw this woman as a <u>person</u> worthy of forgiveness, rather than as an <u>object</u> of scorn (like the Pharisees). What are some ways that you can be sure to affirm people as people and not as objects in our fast-paced, often impersonal society?
