- What titles/names of Jesus do you see in John 1:35-51? Which of these titles are most significant in your opinion?
- How might God be at work in the hearts of others similar to how He was at work in Nathanael? Why is this encouraging to you?
- Who has God placed on your heart to share with about Jesus? How will you do it? When will you do it?
