### QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION:

1. What stood out to you most from the message?
2. What is something that has stood out to you this week from our “Jesse Tree” readings?
3. The helpless condition of Mephibosheth was obvious – he was crippled and in a barren place. How would you describe your lost condition before coming to Christ?
4. What are some ways God demonstrated His love to you while you were lost and apart from Him?
5. Read 2 Samuel 9:7. What expressions of God's love do you see in this verse?
6. We look at three statements of faithful love: “Do not be afraid,” “Do not be ashamed,” “Do not be apprehensive.” Which of these do you need to hear the most right now and why?
7. Read Ephesians 2:1-10. What do you learn about our lost condition, God's faithful love, and our simple choice in this passage?
8. If someone said to you, “I'm just not sure about this idea of Grace, it sounds too easy,” what would you say?
9. Is there anything keeping you from receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior today?
10. Who can we pray for that you are inviting to “An Unexpected Christmas”? Take some time and pray!
