QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION:

1. What stood out to you most from the message?
2. Read Psalms 22:30-31, 48:12-13, 71:17-18, 89:1, 102:18, 145:4. What do we see in these passages about God's passion for next generations to know Him?
3. Read Deuteronomy 29:10-12, 2 Chronicles 20:13, Acts 21:5. Who is present in these important times for God's people? What should we learn from this?
4. Read Matthew 10:42, 11:25-26, 18:2-6, 19:13-14, 21:16, Luke 9:46-48. What do we see about Jesus' ministry? How do his priorities compare with those of His day?
5. How has someone from an older generation helped you to know and follow the Lord lately or throughout the course of your life? How have they specifically added wisdom to your life?
6. How has someone from a younger generation helped you to know and follow the Lord lately or throughout the course of your life? How have they specifically added wonder to your life?
7. Who is God specifically calling you to learn more from in this season? Who is He specifically calling you to teach from a younger generation?
8. Did you commit to "Riding on Route 78" and pursuing to have a purposeful connection with someone from another generation in the next 78 days? Why or why not?
9. What difference would we see in our church in ten years if we all got more serious about fulfilling the vision of Psalm 78?
10. Spend some time praying for us to grow in the vision of Psalm 78 so that next generations will know and follow Jesus!
