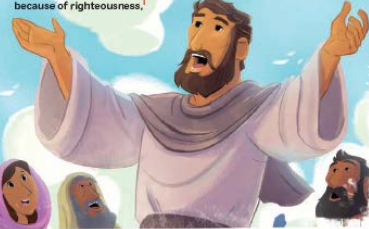

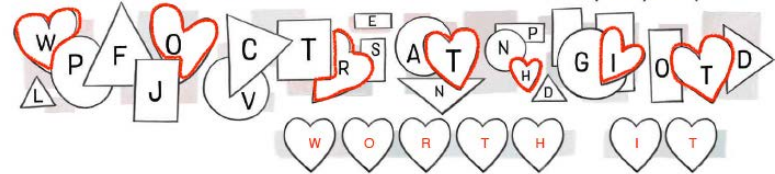

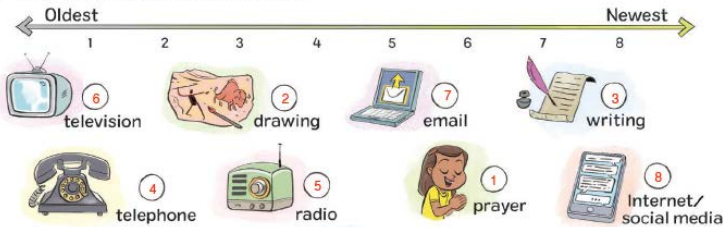

Jesus told His disciples not to worry about food or drink. "Seek God's kingdom," He said, "and God will provide what you need." God is happy to give His children the kingdom.

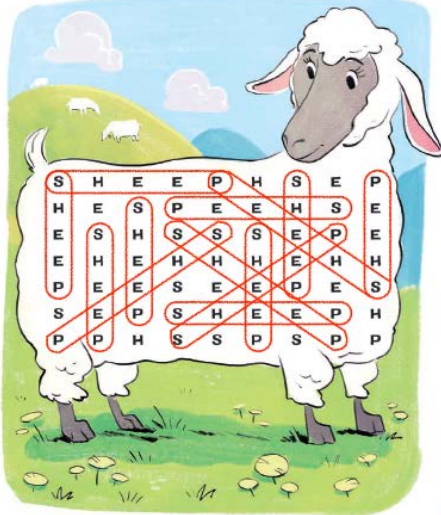

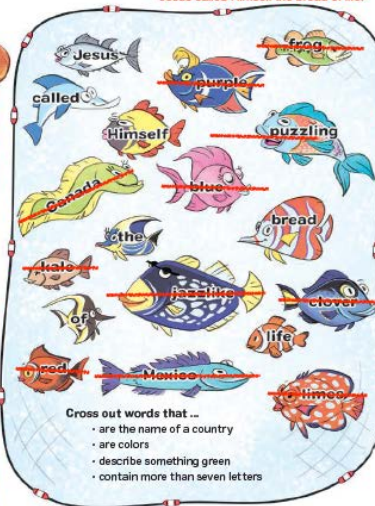


