Matthew 19:3-12, 1 Corinthians 7:10-15

The bad news: You don't have full control of your relationships. The good news: No matter what, you have light and you are loved!

- You have LIGHT!

 Matthew 19:3-12, 1 Corinthians 7:10-15
- Marriage is designed to be a permanent covenant between a man and a woman that glorifies God, testifies to Christ, and reproduces godliness in our world. Believers should prioritize, protect, and persevere in marriage. Gen 2:18-25, Mal 2:13-16, Mat 19:3-6, Eph 5:22-33
- Due to the hardness of our hearts, divorce and remarriage is graciously provided for in cases of adultery or abandonment by an unbeliever. Mat 19:7-9, 1 Cor 7:10-15
- Singleness is a special gift or enablement of God to uniquely advance the kingdom of God. *Mat* 19:12, 1 Cor 7:7, 32-40
- You are LOVED! Isaiah 54:4-5, Hosea 2:19-20, John 4:1-26
- There are no scarlet letters or lonely corners in the kingdom of God!
- You value is not determined by your relational status but by the divine image on you and the divine investment in you.

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

- 1. What stood out to you most from the message?
- 2. Where have you seen Christians lower (liberalism) or raise (legalism) the standards of Scripture in ways that have caused damage?
- 3. Where have you seen Christians apply God's word to difficult situations in ways that have been faithful and that have led to great blessing?
- 4. What are some Bible verses you can think of that encourage us when we feel lonely? (Other than verses we mentioned today)
- 5. Can you share an example of a person who is single who has made a great difference for Christ in the lives of others? Consider examples from the Bible and your own life.
- 6. If you are single, share how you have grown in intimacy with Christ? Also, in what ways can your brothers or sisters in Christ further encourage you?
- 7. Read Isaiah 54:4-5. In your own words, what does it mean that your "Maker is your husband"?
- 8. Read the account of Jesus' grace to a woman caught in adultery in John 7:53-8:11. What lessons do we learn from this account about grace?
- 9. How might our church grow to be even more of a place where people can serve and be served well regardless of relationship status?
- 10. Take some time and pray for one another to know deeper intimacy with God.
