Warning: God's people can and often do miss the mark in worship! (Amos 5:23-24, Matthew 15:7-9)

"What does it mean then to glorify God? It is simply and powerfully to recognize what God is revealing about himself and then respond in a way that exhibits to others those same attributes." - Phil Powers

- The need – Worshippers recognize their desperate need for God.
- The reveal – Worshippers see God clearly.
- The response – Worshippers make it rain on the feet of Jesus.

Worship is...

- humble
- costly
- preoccupied with Jesus
- often emotional
- an open invitation
- not easily hindered

- The key – The fountain of grace is the fuel of love.

## QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

1. What stood out to you most from the message?
2. What is your favorite worship song at the moment and why?
3. Where do you feel you may have missed the mark with regard to worship in the past in some way?
4. What impresses you most about Jesus in this passage (Luke 7:36-50)?
5. In your own words, explain some of the differences between the pharisee and the prostitute.
6. What specific emotions might the worshipping woman been feeling?
7. Read Psalm 90 together. Where do you see emphasis on our need for God in this Psalm? What attributes of God do you see in this Psalm? What response of man to God do you see in this Psalm or is inspired by this Psalm?
8. What is one specific act of worship you can offer to Jesus in the next month, leading up to Easter? What is one act of worship you can offer collectively as a group?
9. How can we guard our hearts from becoming judgmental about the ways in which others are worshipping the Lord?
10. Spend some time praying together for the three requests noted above in the notes.
