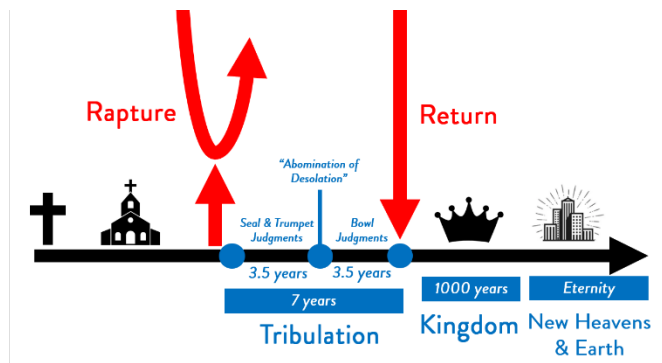


THERE WILL BE SIGNS

GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What stood out to you most from the message?
2. Have you ever had a strange encounter with someone who was teaching on the end times or claiming to know more about the end times than what the Bible reveals?
3. Have our past two messages helped to clarify anything about the future for you? What questions do you still have about the end times?
4. Read John 14:1-6. What comfort does Jesus long for His followers to have?
5. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18. What encouragement can believers take from these words?
6. Read 1 Corinthians 15:50-58. What victory can believers look forward to according to this passage? How should this victory in the future motivate us today?
7. In your own words, explain the rapture.
8. If someone asked you to explain what you believe about the end times, what would you say? (Consider the statement on “Last Things” in our Articles of Faith - www.forcey.org/who-we-are/our-faith/)
9. Titus 2:13 calls our hope of seeing Jesus in the future a “blessed hope.” What do you look forward to most about seeing Jesus?
10. In what specific ways can you better prepare for the Lord’s return?
11. If you were to die today, how sure are you that you would be with Jesus in heaven? What is your certainty based on?
