- 4. Read Galatians 3:1-3. Based on these verses, how might you describe the problem in Galatia?
- 5. Read Galatians 2:21. In your own words, explain what this verse means to vou.
- 6. As we talked about the three gifts of sonship, which one meant the most to you redemption, adoption, or inheritance? Why?
- 7. Read Psalm 73:23-26. What do we learn about our inheritance in these verses?
- 8. How might you encourage someone who feels like God won't forgive them for a specific sin they have committed?
- 9. We have now focused on the theme "Behold Him" for 5 Sundays. What is something you have seen/learned about Jesus in this season that you don't want to forget?
- 10. In your own words, share your "Cinderella story" of salvation how did God save you from slavery and give you a place in his royal family?
