## **GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. What stood out to you most from the message? 2. Share about how you came to personally trust in Christ as your Savior. What difference has Jesus made in your life that you want others to experience? 3. Would you say your life looks more like Joshua (when people were living by faith in God's promise) or Judges (when everyone was doing what was right in their own eves) lately? 4. Share about a time when the Lord's evaluation of your life was different than your own. How did you come to experience conviction and humbly repent and get back on track? 5. Is there "land" in your life that you aren't taking by courageous faith? How might God enable you to experience victory over that sin and take that land! 6. Who is someone (a parent, grandparent, friend, mentor) who passed their faith on to you? How did they help you to receive and take ownership of a relationship with Christ? 7. Read Psalm 78. How many generations are represented in this Psalm? What would have to change if we wanted to get more serious about having this kind of generational impact? 8. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9. How have you seen the principles of this passage play out in the life of your home – either the home you grew up in or the home you are building now? 9. What is most intimidating or overwhelming to you about passing or receiving the baton? Encourage one another! 10. Read Psalm 23:6 and Lamentations 3:22-24. In what area of your life do you most need to receive the mercy of God? Where do you need new beginnings, fresh hope, and a great work of God that you don't deserve?
