**His Faithful Deeds That Point To Jesus**

\*Under the headings below, take note of what you see in Boaz, How that points to Christ, and How you can make your life point to Christ in similar ways:

- A Protector Who Leads Courageously (2:8-9, 22)
  
- A Provider Who Gives Generously (2:14-18, 3:15-17)
  
- A Redeemer Who Loves Sacrificially (2:20, 3:13, 4:5-9)

## GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

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1. What stood out to you most from the message?
2. Where did you find Jesus in the passage?
3. What does the word "Redeem" or "Redemption" mean? Think about the various nuances of the word and discuss how these nuances apply in the gospel.
4. How exactly does the blood of Christ redeem people?
5. Why do you think Ruth found favor in the eyes of Boaz - was it simply because she showed devotion to Naomi? What might another reason be?
6. What words or pictures come to mind when you hear the word, "manly" or "masculine?"
7. How does your concept of masculinity change when you qualify it by saying, "godly masculinity?"
8. In what ways does godliness look different between men and women? How does it look the same?
9. Has God put any marginalized / vulnerable people in your path? How has it been rewarding and/or challenging to show Christ's love and kindness to them?
10. Has anyone ever shown you over-the-top kindness through their protection, provision, or sacrificial love? Explain & share the impact that had on you.
