I. Instructions

We are so thankful you are interested in applying to be part of our team this summer at Forcey Day Camp! Before going any further, please familiarize yourself with the Day Camp ministry and make sure you understand our expectations for team members. Some of the material is new, so make sure you catch it!

Qualifications Nature of	Must be a follower of Jesus Christ; Must have a desire to see others come to faith in Christ; Must enjoy working with children; Must be humble and have a teachable attitude; Must desire to be a part of a team in Christian ministry at Forcey Bible Church. <i>This application and the interview will seek to evaluate these qualifications.</i>
Ministry	Our purpose at Forcey Day Camp is to connect campers to Christ. Therefore, sharing Jesus Christ with our campers (aged 5-12) in word and deed is the focus of the ministry. A weekly schedule is followed, with some different activities each week including games, crafts, field trips, swimming, etc. As in 2023, camp will be divided into three sections (K-1st grade, 2-4th grade, 5-6th grade campers) and campers will follow a different schedule tailored to their age group. Each staff person will primarily work with one of the three age groups, with each group working as a team to reach its particular campers for the Lord. Counselors will lead campers through the day engaging in all activities and taking the opportunities to minister to camper's needs, with the prayer of each one coming closer to Christ.
Components of Training	Sharing the Gospel with children; Team-building; Prayer; managing behavior and disciplining for discipleship; Building relationships with campers; Preparation for Bible lessons and other responsibilities.
Availability	With only 8 weeks of ministry, counselors are expected to make camp a priority, and availability will be considered in hiring. Training Week (June 17-21) is mandatory, and during the camp season (June 24-Aug 9) counselors must be available from 8am to 4pm every day and periodically from 4pm to 6pm for pre-scheduled extended care. It is also an expectation for staff to be available till the end of cleanup on the last day of camp (August 9). The "time-off" policy is that not more than one counselor may be absent from camp on any given day. "Time-off" for pre-scheduled obligations is given on a first-come/first-serve basis only. This year, staff must declare any time of unavailability at their interview – this will be an important component of consideration for hire. Other availability expectations for Counselors include Family Orientation (6/20 at 7:30pm or 6/22 at 10:30am), Ministry Commissioning service (TBA at 9:15 and 11:00 AM), and Family Night (8/1 after camp day until approx. 9:00 PM). Attendance at various other pre-scheduled functions is required upon availability. You are committing to being a part of a team, and teams travel together!
Salary	The salary for Senior Counselor starts at \$480 per week, and Junior Counselor starts at \$400 (plus \$10 extra per week for each of year of previous day camp staff service).
