GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What stood out to you most from the message?
2. In general, what was it like for you to hear the Word of God proclaimed in multiple languages today? What did you see Jesus doing in and through our time of worship together?
3. In honor of Pentecost, spend some time reading through Acts chapter 2 together. What stands out to you about what God did on the Day of Pentecost?
4. Throughout Acts 2, where do you see an emphasis on “all” people? What are some ways we can make sure we are sharing in God’s heart for “all” people today?
5. Why do you think the Lord continues to highlight in Hebrews how Jesus understands and empathizes with our experience? (Hebrews 2:17-18, 4:15)
6. Who is someone you know and appreciate for being a “Man of the People”? What qualities does this person have that makes them this way?
7. Hebrews 4:16 describes the throne of God as a “throne of grace.” How do you envision the “throne of God”? Do you typically think of it as a place of grace? Why or why not?
8. Read 2 Corinthians 12:6-10. What do we learn about God’s grace in this passage? And about how to approach his throne?
9. What are some reasons Christians do not go to the Lord for help? How can we help each other to overcome these reasons?
10. Take some time together to go to the throne of grace right now. Call on the Lord and look for his grace and mercy together.
