GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What stood out to you most from the message?
- 2. What are some sources of comfort in your life that you enjoy as gifts from the Lord?
- 3. Read Matthew 16:21-22. Why do you think it is so difficult for Peter to accept Jesus' statement about his suffering and death?
- 4. Read Matthew 16:24. Is there a difference between the general hardships of life and the "cross-bearing" Jesus calls us to here? Explain.
- 5. Read Matthew 11:28-30. How do you reconcile these verses with Matthew 16:24? How can followers of Jesus both carry a cross and find rest in the Christian life?
- 6. Read Matthew 16:25-26. Have you found it true in you Christian life that losing can be gaining? Explain.
- 7. Read 2 Corinthians 5:14-15. Why is it important to remember that our sacrifice for Jesus is motivated by his love for us? What might be the long-term effects of being motivated by duty alone rather than love?
- 8. Describe a time when you stepped out of your comfort zone to trust and follow Jesus. What did God do? What did you learn?
- 9. Read Galatians 2:20. What are some practical ways a believer can allow "Christ to live in them"?
- 10. Is there something the Lord is asking you to deny of yourself at this time in order to more fully follow him?
