GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What stood out to you the most from the message?
2. In what specific ways were you encouraged about how God is at work in America today?
3. What are some breakthroughs God overcame in your own life to bring you the gospel and to win your heart for Jesus? How did God do this?
4. What "walls" in people's lives today seem the most impenetrable to the gospel?
5. Read Romans 1:16. What might it look like today to be ashamed of the gospel? What might it look like to be more unashamed?
6. Read Colossians 4:2-5. What doors do you see God opening for the gospel in your world?
7. If you were to live with "unwalled faith"—meaning you were completely open to where the Holy Spirit leads and unprotected by your own self-built barriers—what are some things you might do differently?
8. Joshua 6 is often remembered as a moment of triumph, but it began with six days of marching that would have seemed unproductive. In your life, have you ever felt that you were marching in silence while waiting for God to act? How did you keep your faith during the "waiting" period?
9. The Israelites had specific instructions on how to handle the spoils of Jericho (Joshua 6:18-19). What does it look like to be "consecrated" or set apart *after* God gives us a win, rather than letting success lead to greed or self-reliance?
10. Spend some time praying together for the Lord to open doors for the gospel!
