Question: What does it look like for a Christian to delight in the law?

1. Being saved by grace does not mean we neglect God's law

- a. We are not the judge
- b. Serving God means obeying God
- c. Christians can and should delight in the law while still affirming salvation by grace through faith alone.

2. Delighting in the law looks like:

- a. Hanging onto every word of God
- b. Responding to every word of God
